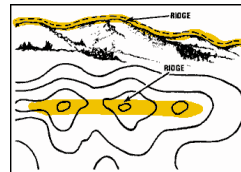
Class starts at 8:30 am and will include three hours of classroom training, 90 minutes of practice, and a two-hour competition.

Learn what Orienteering 'is' and 'is not'.

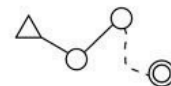
Learn how to use your compass.
